**Creator gives street musicians an opportunity to show their
talent while performing original material.**

Music writer and producer Daniel Cruz is on a mission: to set out to meet remarkable street musicians. He plays them his tunes and they follow, imbuing every one of his phrases with their own style and culture. He listens to their stories and learns about their struggles and victories. Time passes and what started as a hobby becomes a fulltime project. His diary, full of anecdotes, becomes social research. His tape recorder is replaced by a professional mobile recording facility, and the streets of the world become his live studio.

Gypsyhood is written and produced by Daniel Cruz and features street musicians from around the world. The project started in 1998 as an experimental jamming session on the streets of Bogotá, Colombia, and grew into a vision to give street musicians an opportunity to show their talent, while performing original material. In 2006, Gypsyhood was awarded a First Class Project by Middlesex University and SAE London, showing street music has a real contribution to make to society.

Daniel is a sensitive and perceptive musician, and an 'old soul' in this world. His artistic antennae is always absorbing, recognizing, and making sense of our fragile planet and its vibrant travellers. Daniel's compassion is evident in Gypsyhood; it is the work of a man with calloused fingers, and the backing of his family, instead of big record companies. "Our world undervalues street environment diversity," says Daniel. "It is full of interesting insights, and serves as an important temperature check for our culture and future."
